Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!” In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him. “He saved others,” they said, “but he can’t save himself! He’s the king of Israel! Let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, ‘I am the Son of God.’” In the same way the rebels who were crucified with him also heaped insults on him... Jesus cried out in a loud voice, “Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” (which means “MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?... And when Jesus had cried out again in a loud voice, he gave up his spirit. At that moment the curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook, and the rocks split and the tombs broke open... When the centurion and those with him who were guarding Jesus saw the earthquake and all that had happened, they were terrified, and exclaimed, “Surely he was the Son of God!”

Psalms 22:1,7,9,12-24 – My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, so far from the words of my groaning? ...All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads. “He trusts in the LORD,” they say, “let the LORD rescue him. Let him deliver him, since he delights in him... You brought me out of the womb; you made me feel secure on my mother’s breast. From birth I was cast on you; from my mother’s womb you have been my God. Do not be far from me, for trouble is near and there is no one to help... Many bulls surround me; strong bulls of Bashan encircle me. Roaring lions that tear their prey open their mouths wide against me... Dogs surround me, a pack of villains encircles me, they pierce my hands and my feet. All my bones are on display; people stare and gloat over me. They divide my clothes among them and cast lots for my garments. But you, Lord, do not be far from me. You are my strength; come quickly to help me. Deliver me from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dogs. Rescue me from the mouth of the lions; save me from the horns of the wild oxen. I will declare your name to my people; in the assembly I will praise you. You who fear the Lord, praise him! All you descendants of Jacob, honor him! Revere Him, all you descendants of Israel! For he has NOT despised or scorned the suffering of the afflicted one; he has NOT hidden his face from him but has listened to his cry for help.

Luke 23:24 – But Jesus was saying, “Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.”

2Corinthians 5:19 – God was in Christ... Not counting their trespasses against them...
